

The Department of Statistics at Texas A&M University is seeking applications from qualified candidates for the inaugural position as

Director of Statistical Services

for the newly established Department of Statistics Consulting Center. This consulting center is a service offered by the department that provides statistical advice and guidance on a variety of research and clinical studies to faculty, investigators, affiliates and students of Texas A&M University who are engaged in research projects across campus, as well as several clients outside of the university. We provide assistance in

- the design of the experiment or survey;
- determining the appropriate analysis of the data; analyzing the data;
- the interpretation and the conclusions to be drawn from an analysis; and
- grant proposal submission with an emphasis on junior researchers in other disciplines.

The Director will be responsible for the identification, classification and distribution of consulting projects to both on campus and off campus graduate students receiving credit hours for these services, as well as selected core researchers, as part of an impending research grant that is directly associated with this center. The Director will be in charge of the management of these projects as well as the day-to-day operations of the center, including some personal consulting with clients. The Director will report to and work closely with the Department Head, Simon Sheather, as well as select faculty, to define goals and priorities for this center. It is our hope that the Director will seek, define and establish relationships with new clients, including those in government agencies and industry.

Candidates for the position should have a PhD. in statistics, biostatistics, or related field plus 5 years experience in consulting (or M.S. and 10 years of experience). Salary will commensurate with experience. We are dedicated to the goal of building a culturally diverse and pluralistic faculty and staff committed to teaching and working in a multicultural environment and strongly encourages applications from women, minorities, individuals with disabilities, and veterans. This is a non-tenure track position.
