NAISYIN WANG NAMED IMS FELLOW

Naisyin Wang, Professor of Statistics and Toxicology, Texas A&M University was named Fellow of the Institute of Mathematical Statistics (IMS). The induction ceremony took place August 2, 2006 at the IMS Annual Meeting in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

Professor Wang received the award for fundamental contributions in the area of non and semiparametric modeling of longitudinal/clustered data, measurement error problems and imputation inferences; for innovative interdisciplinary contributions; and for valuable editorial service to the profession.

.Each Fellow nominee is assessed by a committee of his/her peers for the award. In 2006, after reviewing 44 nominations, 20 were selected for Fellowship. Created in 1933, the Institute of Mathematical Statistics is a member organization which fosters the development and dissemination of the theory and applications of statistics and probability. The IMS has 4500 active members throughout the world. Approximately 5% of the current IMS membership has earned the status of fellowship.
